
Recap – Summary of Comments from CSD

- Intersection improvements were identified for DB Boulevard and Clipper Drive. The suggestion was made that this could be a roundabout.
- Widening SR 4 to be 4 lanes is not beneficial unless the bridge is four lanes.
- Traffic calming measures are needed.
- Bike lanes are needed for students going to Excelsion Middle School.
- What is the relation between DB AOB and the East County AOB
- A potential 5th high school south of SR4 is proposed. This trip generation should be included in the study



- Nexus Study was prepared based on the recommended Project List
 - Cost Estimates for each project
 - Fair Share calculation per project
 - Calculated maximum allowable fee

Calculated Fee Rate

Land Use	Current Fee Rate	Calculated Fee Rate	East County AOB fee	Brentwood Fee Rate
Single Family	\$1,538	\$25,678	\$9,305	\$11,601
Multi Family	\$ 938	\$15,763	\$5,344	\$7,193
Commercial	\$2.18/square feet	\$36.44/sf	\$9.38/sf	\$4.32/sf
Office	\$1.77/sf	\$29.47/sf	\$6.50/sf	\$5.18/sf

^{*}All of these fee areas also include a mandatory Regional Traffic Fee of \$20,640/single family, \$12,670/multi-family, \$1.74/sf commercial, \$1.51/sf office

Decision on Fee Rate

- Cannot impose higher fees than calculated rate
- But it can be less for reasons such as to encouraging jobs & services to the area, general economic stability, etc.
