This helps the Town see what the public is interested in.
- 2. Discussion Regarding Town Phone System. Assistant General Manager, Dina Breitstein discussed the possible purchase of a new phone system for the Town. The new phone system will reduce cost to the Town while simultaneously save the Town roughly \$11,000.00 a year. Upon considering the Town's needs, Jive, Vonage and Ring Central were each reviewed and assessed. Jive was the company that met all the requirements of the district.
