D. DISCUSSION ITEMS

- 1. Discussion Regarding the 2020 Parks and Recreation Public Event Calendar. Parks and Recreation Manager, Monica Gallo presented a Calendar of Community Events for 2020.
- 2. Discussion Regarding the 2020 Program, Activity, and Event Waivers. Parks and Recreation Manager, Monica Gallo discussed Fee Waiver. General Manager can waive fees for programs, activities and events within the Parks and Recreation Department.
- 3. Discussion Regarding an RFP for the Ravenswood Play Structure. Landscape Manager, Bill Engelman discussed the replacement of the play structure at Ravenswood Park. Three quotes were obtained from different structure vendors for playground equipment manufacturers/ distributors. The chosen option, Landscape Structures, was selected due to the quality and aesthetics of the structure presented. It will be installed in Zone 9.
- 4. Community Center and Landscaping list of deferred maintenance items including cost. Prioritized list of landscaping needs has been drafted and was presented to the Board. The Town has the need to reconstruct several sites which required attention. Landscape Manager, Bill Engelman discussed the importance of investing in these landscaping projects. Chair Kevin Graves recommended bringing these projects to the attention of the rest of the Board at the next Regular Board Meeting.
- 5. Discussion on Recreation Services Department Annual Report for FY18-19. Parks and Recreation Manager, Monica Gallo generated the annual report and it will be presented at a future board meeting on March 18, 2020.
