E. WATER AND WASTEWATER UPDATE

Water/Wastewater Manager Aaron Goldsworthy provided an update on Water projects.

- Underwater Crossing at Marina and Marlin currently undergoing a trial with LED lighting for the marina.
 Currently 3 lights have been switched out to LED on a trial basis. We are looking to see if they give off too
 much light and checking with residents who live around there to confirm marina is lit properly at night. Currently
 all outside lights run off timer at the marina harbor itself. We are in motion converting that connection to
 photocells. This way there will be a constant source to the light poles so we can tie onto cathodic protection
 for the underwater crossing.
- Filter is complete at Willow Lake. Everything has been painted and is back in service.
- Pipeline Project bids are due on March 8th at 11am. We completed a mandatory walk through with all the contractors and made some corrections to the scope of the project after contractors posed some important questions. Gregory Harris from Herwit was involved in that decision.

Water/Wastewater Manager Aaron Goldsworthy provided an update on wastewater projects.

- Manhole project has been approved. Contract will be out to the is moving forward.
- Denitrification project is progressing. Slight delay of 3-4 weeks due to rainy weather.

F. <u>DISCUSSION ITEMS</u>

1. Discussion Regarding the Digest Pond Repairs and the Dredge.

Acknowledged the hard work of Veolia sharing that our lagoons and digest ponds have looked the best they ever have in 11 years. Dredge works great and moves the sludge over efficiently. Digest pond is completed and back in service.
