### **Executive Summary**

In August 2012, the Discovery Bay Public Financing Authority issued \$14,100,000 in Series 2012 Enterprise Revenue Bonds and in April of 2017 the PFA issued \$8,825,000 in series 2017 Enterprise Revenue Bonds. Per the terms of the financing and agreement between the members of the Joint Powers Authority (Discovery Bay Public Financing Authority and the Byron Bethany Public Financing Authority (PFA)); an annual meeting of the PFA must take place. The PFA last met on December 20, 2017.

The staff of the PFA is pleased to present the list of projects that the PFA identified in the *Official Statement*, and the status of those projects: Bond funds are expended on the 2012 Bond as of June 30, 2014 and the remaining balance on the 2017 Bond as of June 2018. Additionally, annual Debt Service payments have been met and payment information is included in the summary.

The DBPFA financed \$14.1M in Capital Projects in August 2012. Water projects totaled \$1.5M, while Wastewater projects accounted for \$12.6M of the overall project costs. The DBPFA financed \$8,825,000 in April 2017 \$1.5M for the Water project and \$7.4M for the Wastewater project. The project title and budget allocations for each project, and account balances as of June 30, 2018, are as follows:
