1. Vac Truck Update

- Vac truck will be delivered first week of December. This is earlier than originally anticipated.
- 2. Denitrification Project Update

Update provided by Gregory Harris, Herwit Engineering. Water & Waterwater Manager Aaron Goldsworthy also provided drone photos.

- New rotors are being installed.
- Oxidation Ditch No. 4 may come online in November.
- Original finish date was June 15, 2023. Updated Finish date is now August 21, 2023. The two month delay was due to Covid/supply chain issues.
- Two basins and two oxidation ditches will be online by February or March 2023.

3. Diffuser Project Update

Update provided by Gregory Harris, Herwit Engineering.

- Original project was cancelled and it was decided that divers would be utilized to assess the project. Many of the pre-ordered materials were able to be cancelled. Items that were not cancelled may be sold in the future to Veolia for alternate projects.
- Underwater Resources in under contract for divers. Preliminary dive scheduled for mid-September to evaluate what is broken/missing.
