Contra Costa Fire: At a Glance

All-Hazards, full-service district

- Over 600 employees
 - Firefighters and civilian staff
- 35 Strategically placed fire stations covering 553 sq. miles
- Large apparatus fleet
 - Fire engines, boats, rescues, hazmat, etc.
- Dedicated administration, training, fleet, communications, and wellness facilities
- Prevention Bureau
 - Investigations, plan review, public education, code enforcement
- Paramedic on every apparatus
- FEMA US&R and Cal OES HazMat teams
- Regional Fire & EMS Communications Center



2024 Accomplishments:

- Fire Academy 60
 - 13 Contra Costa Fire and 4 Moraga-Orinda recruits
- Two new ladder trucks and six new fire engines
- Byron Wildfire Training Center Grand Opening
- Seasonal Aerial Firefighting Helicopter Contract

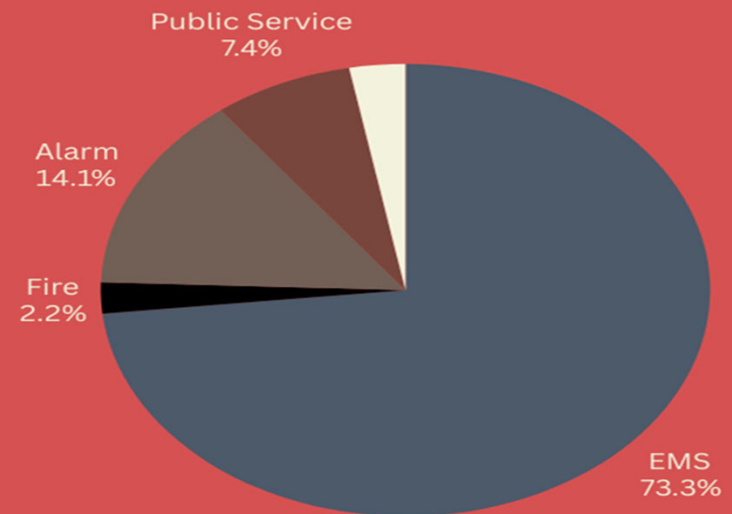
