A. ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order at 4:05 P.M. by CSD Director Tetreault

B. <u>SELECTION OF COMMITTEE OFFICERS</u>

Director Tetreault was nominated for Committee Chair and Director Steele was nominated for Committee Vice-Chair. The nominations were passed by a unanimous vote.

C. BROWN ACT REVIEW AND REQUIREMENTS OF COMMITTEE MEMBERS

General Manager Howard provided the Committee with a review of the Brown Act and its application to the Committee and its members.

D. SUMMARY AND REVIEW OF COMMUNITY CENTER EFFORTS TO DATE

General Manager Howard presented a series of photos that depicted sites and locations that have previously been considered as possible sites for a community center in Discovery Bay. Former General Manager and current Water and Wastewater Manager Virgil Koehne reviewed past efforts of the District and past Community Center Committees' efforts as well.

A lengthy discussion ensued on the needs of the community and what should be included in a future community center. It was agreed upon that Committee Member O'Toole will prepare a survey to the community and bring that back to the Committee at the next meeting for review or consideration.

General Manager Howard presented a listing of fifteen (15) local community centers for possible Committee visits. The committee would like to schedule a tour at a future date.

Resident Jeff Barber complimented the Committee on its efforts and is hopeful the meaningful results will come from the committee's efforts. He recommended the committee conduct Due Diligence, and that the committee consider fabric tension facilities in addition to brick and mortar.

Resident Pat Richardson commented that athletic fields for tournaments could provide a revenue source.

E. <u>DISCUSSION OF FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS AND FUTURE FUNDING OPPORTUITIES</u>

General Manager Howard presented the current approximate funds available for the project at approximately \$1.8 Million not including any opportunities that may exist with what is known as the "Twelve Lots". Mr. Howard also discussed potential funding opportunities with the possible creation of a Community Center Foundation. A Foundation could be established to be an independent fundraising mechanism which would raise funds for possible land acquisition, design and construction, as well as ongoing operations. Mr. Howard will explore this opportunity and provide additional information to the Committee at its next meeting.
